In preparation for our 150th Birthday celebrations, we are making a very special altar cloth for use during collective worship. All pupils in the school have contributed ideas and artwork that they believe represents the Christian foundation and everyday life of our school.

Mrs Maggie Thackway, one of our foundation governors, successfully applied for a grant that has allowed us to buy in the help of artist Elisa Amor. Ms Amor has worked on the project with an Altar Cloth Committee consisting of Alex, Alfie, Evelyn, Georgie, Isis P, Kai, Leighton, Lolabelle and Zachary.

The Committee chose to represent a season of the year on each side of the altar cloth. Each side includes a tree to represent one of our classes; religious symbolism appropriate to the season; reference to our rural setting; and an aspect of life in our school. The beautiful designs that Ms Amor created from the children's ideas are shown below.



During Monday 9th March and Tuesday 10th March, Mrs Thackway and Ms Amor will work with small groups of children (all pupils take part over the two days) to sew and stick the collage together. Once all of the panels are complete, Ms Amor will stitch them together to create a wonderful birthday present for the school. The sessions will run as follows –
