RE: NSPCC's Speak out. Stay safe. online programme

As you are aware, this term we participated in the **NSPCC's** *Speak out. Stay safe.* online programme. This consisted of an online assembly and supporting classroom based activities. *Speak out. Stay safe.* is a safeguarding programme available to all primary schools in the UK and Channel Islands. It aims to help children understand abuse in all its forms and to recognise the signs of abuse in a child friendly, interactive way. Children are taught to speak out if they are worried, either to a trusted adult or Childline.

Feedback - NSPCC pupil online survey (for pupils in Key Stage 2)

The NSPCC would like to gather pupil feedback about the online assembly in order to gauge their understanding about the key messages of speaking out and staying safe.

This will be completely voluntary. If you have agreed that your child can take part in the survey but your child changes his or her mind on the day, that is okay.
