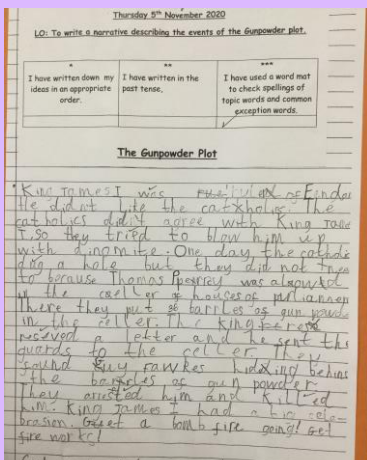

We have enjoyed learning a song about the continents.

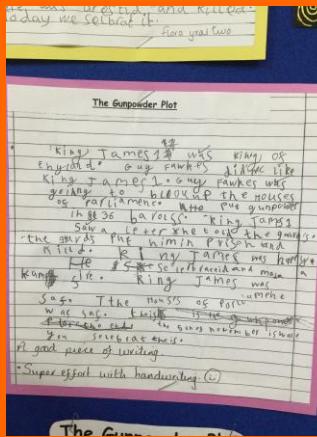
We are learning to name, locate and share a fact about each
