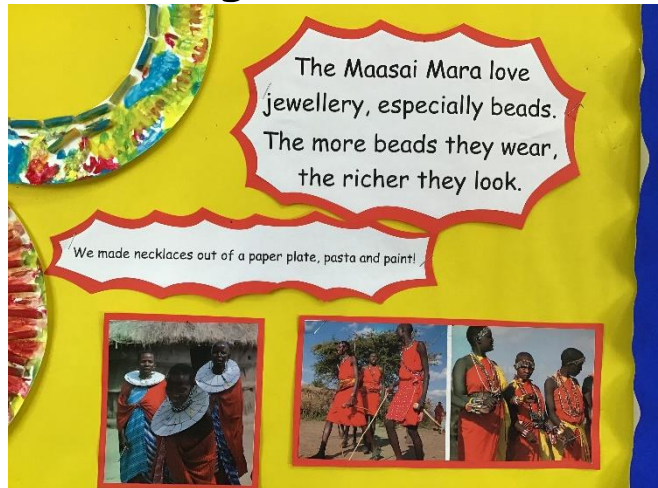


# Willow class Newsletter

## Sensational Safari

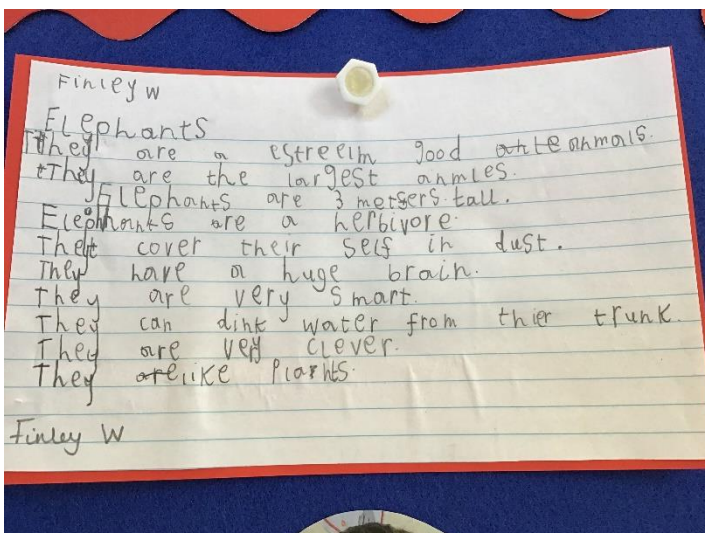
We produced some sensational art work. Can you spot some of the Big Five?

3.2m tall! WOW!

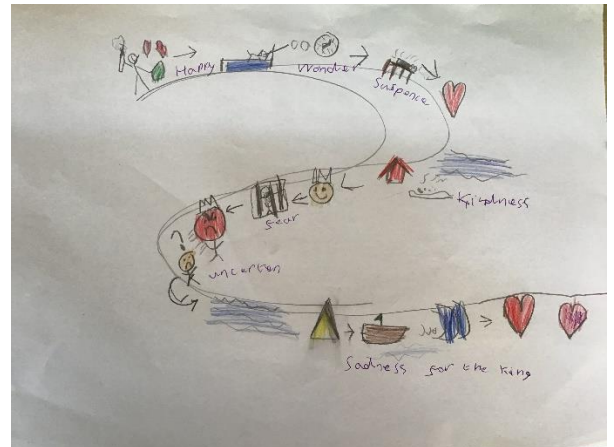
We are currently learning the story, 'The Magic Paintbrush'. A story map is helping us to re-tell the story. We are going to write the story next week.

We are learning about primary colours and how to mix these to

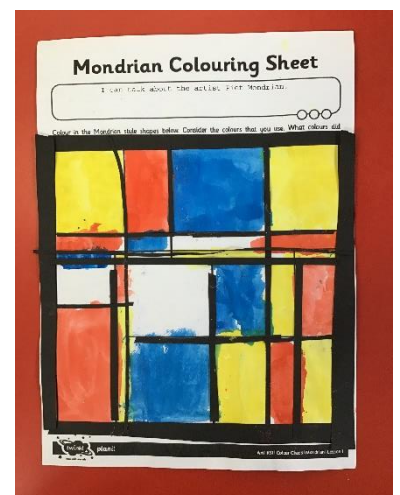
make secondary colours. We have produced some stunning artwork in the style of Piet Mondrian.
