

## English

**WW2 Battle of Britain** - children will study fiction and non-fiction texts relating to the Battle of Britain. They will use what they have learnt to write their own recounts, propaganda posters using persuasive language and write historical stories about this major turning point of World War II.

**Narrative Writing** - children will have the opportunity to consolidate skills learnt so far to write their own narrative.

**End of focus topic essays** - children write an essay based on the key question of each focus topic.

### Year 5

#### Fractions:

#### Algebra:

Finding rules; forming expressions; substitution; forming & solving equations; finding pairs of values.
