Dear Parents

Your child's 2021 school report will be in your child's bag at the end of today.

We have graded Reception pupils in line with Early Years goals; a table on the report explains the grading for exceeding, secure and working towards the early years goals.

Assessment for pupils in years 1 to 6 is described in terms of an "expected standard" at the end of KS1 (Y2) and an "expected standard" at the end of KS2 (Y6). The national Expected Standard is a wide band that incorporates the most able pupils.

The following grades have been used in our reports for Years 1-6 to give you a clear idea of how your child is doing:

## **Attainment**

| <b>1 Exceeding</b> | Pupil is on track to achieve the expected national standard for the key stage or would have achieved the expected standard in a normal year.   |
| <b>2 Secure</b>    | Pupil is on track to achieve the expected national standard for the key stage or would have achieved the expected standard in a normal year.   |
| <b>3 Some Gaps</b> | Pupil is not quite on track to achieve the expected national standard for the key stage or may not have achieved the expected standard in a normal year.   |
| <b>4 Many Gaps</b> | Pupil is likely to need additional support to achieve the expected national standard for the key stage, may not achieve the expected national standard for the key stage, or would not have achieved the expected standard in a normal year. |

Your child's report is individual to him/her and should not be compared to another child's report. However, as a general guide:

- Reports which contain mostly 1s and As will indicate significant achievement and will represent a minority of reports.
- Reports which contain mostly Cs and Ds for effort may indicate that improvement is required
