Message from the Head Teacher

Dear Parents,

There are so many reasons to be proud of our children and school community. Let me list just a few for you...

Congratulations to **Daisy** who passed her Grade 2 piano in the summer. We love to hear about the successes of our pupils outside of school – parents are invited to send in medals, certificates and trophies to class teachers on Fridays for inclusion in our Celebration Assembly.

Many of our Year 6 pupils made speeches to the school, seeking election as House Captain. After an exciting vote, I am delighted to confirm the following – Blue House Captain, **Amelie** and Deputy, **Harry**; Green House Captain, **Tabitha** and Deputy, **Nathaniel**; Yellow House Captain, **Lolabelle** and Deputy, **Kitty**; and Red House Captain, **Phoenix** and Deputy, **Joshua**. Congratulations to all of these children.

Several pupils sought election to school council, making speeches and presentations to their own classes in the first round. For the final round, we held formal voting with ballot papers in the hall. I would like to congratulate the following children on their success – in Blossom, **Seren and Theo**; in Willow, **Flora and Isaac P**; in Oak, **Holly and Alfie**; and in Redwood, **Tabitha and Phoenix**. Well done to all of the candidates.

Our small school community has helped the wider community through a number of charitable initiatives since September. A huge thank you to pupils, parents and staff for the generous donations that resulted in 98kg of produce for Warminster Foodbank; a donation of £111 to Macmillan Cancer Support; and our on-going collection for the Royal British Legion.

Another community link that we enjoy is with the Dorset and Wiltshire Fire Brigade. In assembly last week, our children listened intently while Firefighter Paul (virtually) told us a story about bonfire night and checked all the important safety rules for lighting fires and using fireworks. Chapmanslade pupils understand the importance of being respectful, responsible citizens.

On the sporting front, almost a third of our pupils have taken part in cross country running competitions over the last few weeks. At Warminster School, the Chapmanslade team came third overall, and we were all so proud of our highest placed runner, **Erin F**, who took the bronze medal in the Y3/4 Girls race. Last Friday, we entered teams into the Stonar School XC. The children were fantastic, digging deep to run the challenging course. Our highest placed athlete was **Amelie**, who took bronze in the Y5/6 Girls race. Well done!

We look forward to welcoming parents to our combined Nativity & Carol Service in the last week of this term. Please be as flexible as possible about which performance you attend. Covid restrictions permitting, tickets will be confirmed by the end of November. Dismissal

Please help to minimise crowding on the school driveway, and to ease parking on the High Street, by leaving promptly once you have collected your child. Only one adult from each household should wait on the driveway, and if you are collecting a sibling group, please do not arrive until 3:10pm. We will dismiss children without siblings before we begin to dismiss sibling groups. We are very happy to dismiss our older children to walk home alone or to meet parents at an agreed place in the village as long as we have those instructions in writing.
