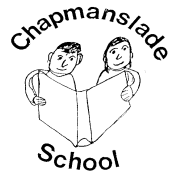

SCIENCE INVESTIGATION

Dear Parents,

Blossom Class will be continuing to investigate the properties of materials next term to answer the question:

Which is the best material to keep Ted dry?

We would therefore like each child to bring in 3 different materials for testing: ideally one they think is waterproof; one that is not; and one they are not sure about.

Suitable materials could include: part of a plastic bag, a balloon, cardboard, fabric or a piece of wrapping paper. The materials do not need to be large, just big enough to easily cover the top of a jam jar. We also need a number of clean jam jars or clear plastic pots for this experiment; if you have any please to spare send them in.

These items are needed in school by **Monday 28th February** (the first day of term) when we will begin our experiments.
