Message from the Head Teacher

Dear Parents,

Well, that was an unexpected end to the term! It was a difficult decision to close last night, although the right one as Wiltshire made the decision to advise their schools to close early this morning. The unexpected closure has caused a few changes to today's plans – please see below for details about interim reports and parents evening slots. Year 6 revision guides were also scheduled to arrive today, but we will now look out for these after half term.

It has been a productive and busy last couple of weeks in school. It has been great to get back closer to normality in school, with a significant reduction in Covid-19 cases. We have managed to hold our first long-awaited School Council meeting – the councillors already have some lovely ideas, which we will continue to explore next term.

Sadly, we say goodbye to Maxi this week and wish him all the best at his new school. I can confirm that I will continue to act up in Mrs Chapman's absence for the beginning of next term. I will continue to teach in Oak Class on a Monday and Mrs Fitzsimmons will continue to teach in Oak Class Tuesday – Friday on a supply basis until further notice.

Last week, we enjoyed an assembly from Fun Science, who will be running our science club next term. This club filled up quickly! On Wednesday, we were visited by Mark from Newland Homes to tell us all about the new housing development. It was great to see the plans (especially the new play area!) and to see some of our learning in the real world. We were shown how the houses are all sustainable and how they are environmentally friendly, linking in with geography learning. Linking in with science, we were shown how the houses generate electricity and how new habitats will be created for animals and insects. One of these habitats will be a bee hotel made by a class at Chapmanslade! Each class now has the materials to design and make a bee hotel next term. At least one of these will go in the show home garden in April. We plan to visit the site to see this in the future.

Redwood Class made us proud on Wednesday with their performance at the West Wiltshire Dance Festival in the Bath Forum. Their Doctor Who inspired dance impressed all and was truly unique within the dances from other schools that performed the event theme of *Back to The Future*. Well done to Redwood Class! Thank you to Miss Dyer, Mrs Allen and Mrs Knight, who have been working hard to choreograph the dance over the past term.

Yesterday, Oak and Redwood classes enjoyed a music technology workshop from Conductive Music. The workshop consisted of combining Music and Technology, as well as making other strong links across the curriculum: some of the history of Music & Technology and Mathematical coding. Children were each given a 'microbit' which they could connect to their laptops via a USB. The children were then taught how to code the 'microbit' via an online app and this enabled them to make their own music which could be played through the chip. The children thoroughly enjoyed their sessions as they had never had experience with this sort of technology and were thrilled to be given the opportunity. Blossom and Willow's workshop was supposed to be today, so will be re-arranged, hopefully for next term.

Interim Progress Reports were due to go out today. These will now be sent out on the first day back after half term, Monday 28th February. Parents Evening slots were also due to be sent out. These were in the process of being finalised and will now be sent out early next week due to the files being in school. So far, we have been able to accommodate all parent's requests for slots.
