Dear Parents,

Firstly, thank you for your patience over the past few weeks. It has been a challenge for us all with Covid-19 pupil, parent and staff absences, but hopefully we are through the worst of it. As you may be aware, Mrs McCall has been unwell for several weeks, so I apologise if we have taken longer than usual to respond to queries or welcome you at the office in the mornings. Miss Parton is working in the office in the afternoons.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all of our staff and governors at Chapmanslade, who have gone above and beyond over the past weeks to keep the school safe and thriving. This includes our contractors Lataca, who provide our lunches and Busy Bees 2000, who clean and maintain our site.

Our Christian value this term is *Wisdom*. We have been talking about Wisdom in class and during Collective Worship assemblies.
