#### <u>English</u>

In English, we have had a strong focus on Narrative writing. Redwood children have been required to use their imagination to compose their own fictional story. Our lessons have consisted of creating detailed character and setting descriptions and building up our writing using Story Mountains to support us. The children have presented some fantastic work which they cannot wait to share once finished!

Our next focus will be on writing our own poetry inspired by a variety of different poets and performers.

#### Geography

We have just started our new topic 'Magnificent Mountains' and have learnt about the different mountain ranges in the world and in the UK itself. Children are able to use atlases and online resources to help them locate these places; a key skill for a geographer!

## <u>Maths</u>

In Mathematics we have been focusing on metric (m, cm, g, kg, tonnes etc) and imperial measurements (inches, feet, pounds, stone etc). Real life examples of these measurements are the best way to remember them – have a go at some baking!

We have more recently moved onto area and perimeter of shapes. All children should be able to recall what the formula for the area of a triangle is off by heart!

### **Science**

We have recently started looking at the key question – 'How do scientists classify living things?' We have investigated the 'Linnaean system' and how animals are classified; all the way from the domain to individual species. The children have been producing some beautiful posters to give information on the different sorts of invertebrates and vertebrates in the animal kingdom. ## Other Subjects

PSHE – the main focus this term is thinking positively. We will be exploring how thoughts, feelings and behavior link, choices and consequences, having an 'I can' attitude and facing your feelings.

RE – this term we are focusing on Christianity, in particular – the Gospels. We are looking at the teachings of Jesus; how that impacted the lives of many at the time and how Christians can use his teachings today.
