## **Sports Day - Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2022 1:30pm**

We look forward to welcoming you to our sports day next Wednesday. Please help us to make this occasion a huge success by ensuring that your child is prepared for the event:

- Pupils should arrive at school on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> July wearing PE shorts and **house colour polo shirt** with sturdy trainers. They should bring a named drinks bottle (and packed lunch in a fully disposable packaging if required) but nothing else. Hot lunch will be provided for pupils as usual in the dining hall.
- Pupils may wear a sun hat or cap. If required, all day sun cream should be applied in the morning.
- Parents are very welcome to spectate; bring your own folding seat or blanket to sit on. Please note that there is no shade on the field. Gates open for parents at 1:20pm. Please park safely and considerately avoiding white lines and driveways, leaving clear access to the farm and pub. Please walk to school if you can.
- Races begin at 1:30pm. There will be a short closing ceremony and the event will end at about 2:45pm.
- Children will be dismissed from the top gate as usual straight after Sports Day. Any child whose parent did not attend Sports Day, and those attending Busy Bees, will be looked after until 3:15pm.
- **Parents and younger siblings must remain on the outside of the race tape.** Pupils are at school and will remain with class teachers and other staff until dismissed. These measures are for your child's safety.
- If taking part in the Leavers' Race, Year 6 pupils should bring a small suitcase of dressing up clothes to school in the morning. All other equipment will be provided by the school.
- If excessive heat or heavy rain makes conditions dangerous we may be forced to cancel at very short notice. The safety of the children is our main consideration.

Sports Day is a special event for the children with a focus on participation and fun. Parents are very welcome to join us and I look forward to seeing many of you at the event.
